Cleanse/irrigate wound with sterile normal saline or agency		Reduces wound debris and allows for adhesion of
approved wound cleanser; dry peri-wound skin.		dressing or tape.
If required, apply a skin barrier to peri-wound skin.		To protect the peri-wound skin from maceration and
		to improve the adhesion of the dressing tape.
To Apply		
Choose a dressing size that will ensure that the dressing extends		Incorrect sizing will adversely affect the dressing
at least 2cm beyond wound edge.		absorption functionality.
Dressing may be cut – cut edge may be taped if needed.		
Apply directly on the wound as a primary dressing or in		
combination with another wound product as a secondary cover		
dressing.		
Secure in place with tape, kling or mesh (eg stockinet).		
To Remove		
Gently remove the dressing from wound.		
If the dressing adheres to the wound, soak it with tap water or		The dressing will become heavy as it absorbs moisture.
remove in shower. Allow dressing to become saturated and then		
gently remove it.		
Frequency of Dressing Change		
Will depend upon the amount of exudates. Dressing may be left		
in place until it becomes very heavy with wound exudate.		
Expected Outcome		
Exudate is managed with no peri-wound skin maceration.
