Remedy Cleanse No Rinse	
<b>Classification</b>	<b>Skin Care: Cleanser – No Rinse</b>
<b>British Columbia Practice</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The British Columbia Perinatal Services and the British Columbia Provincial Nursing Skin &amp; Wound Committee have determined that Remedy Cleanse may be used a rinse-off cleanser (see specific application below) for:                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Neonates in NICU with a corrected gestational age greater than 31 weeks + 6 days.</li> <li>Neonates in the maternity/pediatric units who are less than 28 days in age.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Key Points</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remedy Clinical Cleanse No-Rinse Cleanser is a no-rinse pH-balanced, plant-derived moisturizing foam cleanser for skin and hair.</li> <li>May be used on intact and non-intact skin.</li> <li>Fragrance free, tear free, hypoallergenic, paraben free, sulfate free.</li> <li>Chlorhexidine Gluconate (CHG) compatible.</li> <li>Compatible with latex, nitrile, and vinyl gloves.</li> </ul>
<b>Indications</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For bathing (bed or basin), perineal cleansing, hair cleansing: for all ages of patients/clients/residents including babies who are 28 days or greater in age.</li> <li>For the removal of zinc-based ointments: for all ages including neonates with a corrected gestational age greater than 31 weeks + 6 days and those on the maternity/pediatric units.</li> </ul>
<b>Precautions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For external use only. May be used for cleansing eyelids/lashes but avoid direct contact to the eye.</li> </ul>
<b>Contraindications</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not use for clients with known sensitivity or allergy to product ingredients.</li> <li>Do not use for Neonates who have a corrected gestational age of less than 31 weeks + 6 days.</li> <li>Do not use as a wound cleanser.</li> </ul>
<b>Formats &amp; Sizes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bottle with foaming applicator:                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>118mL</li> <li>236mL</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <div style="text-align: center;"> </div>

Directions	Rationale / Key Points
<b>Selection</b>	
Select the size of bottle appropriate to the client situation, (e.g., for short stay consider the 118 mL sized bottle).  Label the bottle with the date and the client’s name.	The bottle is for single-patient use only and is to be used within three years of opening.
<b>Application</b>	
<b>Bathing (bed or basin) all ages except neonates</b> (see below) A maximum of 10 pumps is all that is needed for a complete bath: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Moisten a soft, reusable or disposable cloth with warm water.</li> <li>Use the palm of the hand to dispense 1-3 pumps of the cleanser onto the washcloth.</li> <li>Cleanse the skin gently; <u>do not rinse</u> with water; pat skin dry.</li> <li>Repeat process for the other body parts.</li> <li>Follow with an application of a moisturizer or a skin</li> </ul>	Do not use in the shower.  Cleanser is a no-rinse product and leaves an invisible protective moisturizing film on the skin.



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Directions	Rationale / Key Points
<p>protectant.</p> <p><b>Bathing for Neonates:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use the foam cleanser to wash the infant’s hair and body as per usual neonatal unit’s practice/procedure for immersion or sponge bath.</li> <li>• Pat skin dry.</li> <li>• Do not apply moisturizer.</li> <li>• If needed, apply silicone protectant, (e.g., Remedy Protect to perineal area).</li> </ul>	<p>Due to the permeability of the neonatal skin, minimize the use of skin moisturizers /protectants unless needed, (e.g., Incontinence Associated Dermatitis).</p>
<p><b>Hair cleansing:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Apply to wet or dry hair.</li> <li>• Moisten all strands working it in gently.</li> <li>• Do not rinse.</li> <li>• Towel dry.</li> </ul>	<p>Product does not produce suds.</p> <p>Cleanser is a no-rinse product.</p>
<p><b>Perineal cleansing:</b></p> <p>Gently remove as much of the feces as possible:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Moisten a washcloth with warm water. Use the palm of the hand to dispense 3-6 pumps of the cleanser on to the washcloth. More pumps can be used.</li> </ul> <p><u>Or</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pump directly onto perineal skin/soiling on skin/zinc barrier. For caked-on, dried soiled areas, allow the foam to soak in for 2-3 minutes to aid in cleansing.</li> <li>• Wipe gently and repeat as necessary.</li> <li>• Do not rinse the skin with water, pat dry.</li> <li>• Apply a thin layer of skin protectant or skin barrier.</li> </ul>	<p>Cleanser is a no-rinse product and leaves an invisible protective moisturizing film on the skin.</p>
<p><b>Removal of Zinc Cream:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pump directly onto the zinc area.</li> <li>• Allow the foam to soak in for 2-3 minutes to aid in removing cream.</li> <li>• Wipe gently off the top layer of zinc and repeat if needed.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Expected Outcomes</b></p>	
<p>Clean, moisturized skin.</p> <p>Product performs as expected.</p>	<p>If product does not perform as expected, notify NSWOC/Wound Clinician and then consider submitting a <a href="#">Supply Chain Product Concern Form</a>.</p>
