Remedy Moisturize Lip Balm		
Classification	Skin Care: Moisturizer - Lips	
Key Points	 Unscented, aloe-based, paraben-free moisturizer in a tube applicator. Does not contain petrolatum or petrolatum-derivative ingredients; may be used for the client receiving oxygen therapy (nasal prongs or mask). Does not contain sunscreen protectant ingredients. 	
Indications	• For ages 3 years and older for the prevention or treatment of dry to very dry lips.	
Precautions	Not to be used as a sunscreen protector for lips.	
Contraindications	Sensitivity or allergy to aloe vera or other components of the moisturizer.	
Formats & Sizes	• Tube: • 4.25gm	

Directions	Rationale / Key Points		
Preparation			
Ensure lips and surrounding skin are clean prior to application.			
Remove the cap of the tube and turn the wheel on the bottom of the tube to the right to advance the column of moisturizer above the level of the top of the tube.	Tube is single-client use only.		
Application			
Apply a light layer of the moisturizer to lips and if needed the immediate surrounding area.			
Excess moisturizer can be removed by gently dabbing area with tissue or cloth.			
Turn the wheel on the bottom of the tube to the left to return the column of moisturizer down below the level of the top of the tube. Reapply the cap to the tube.	Returning the column of moisturizer back inside the tube will ensure the moisturizer does not dry out.		
Removal			
To remove all of the moisturizer, use a warm cloth and gently cleanse the lips and surrounding area.			
Frequency of Application			
Apply as needed.			
Expected Outcomes			
If used to prevent dry lips, the condition does not develop.	If product does not perform as expected, notify		
If used as a treatment for dry to very dry lips, improvement is noted, or the condition resolves.	NSWOC/Wound Clinician and then consider submitting a <u>Supply Chain Product Concern Form</u> .
