Payment for Ostomy Supplies

THIRD PARTY AND PRIVATE HEALTH INSURANCE

- Third-party health insurance is often provided by an employer. People can also buy private health insurance.
- You must use this option if it's available to you.
- Insurance companies offer different benefits. Contact your insurer for information about coverage for ostomy supplies.

The following Government of Yukon Programs may be able to assist with the purchase of ostomy supplies:

VETERANS AFFAIRS

 If you are or were a member of the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF), or Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) you may be seek coverage through <u>Veterans Affairs Canada</u>. For questions about your coverage contact Veteran Affairs 1-866-522-2122

PHARMACARE AND EXTENDED HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAMS

- Yukon seniors have access to Pharmacare and Extended Health Benefits programs.
- These programs assist registered seniors with the cost of prescription drugs; dental care, eye care, and medical-surgical supplies and equipment. This includes most ostomy supplies.
- You must be 65 or older, or between 60 and 64 and married to someone 65 or over.
- These programs are the insurer of last resort. If you receive health insurance benefits through your employer or third party, claims must be submitted to these insurers first.
- Pre-approval is mandatory.

CHRONIC DISEASE AND DISABILITY BENEFITS PROGRAM

- The <u>Chronic Disease and Disability Benefits Program</u> provides assistance to Yukoners who have a chronic disease or disability.
- This program can help cover the costs of prescription drugs, medical supplies, and equipment, including ostomy supplies.

- The program is the insurer of last resort. If you receive health insurance benefits through your employer or third party, claims must be submitted to these insurers first.
- Pre-approval is mandatory.



- Program recipients must pay the first \$250 of eligible costs per year, to a maximum of \$500 per family. You can apply to have these costs reduced, depending on your income and family size.

PALLIATIVE CARE

- If you are receiving end-of-life care (palliative care) and are enrolled in one of the programs above, you may also be eligible for additional assistance.
- Have your physician fill out the "Palliative care acknowledgement" form.

NON-INSURED HEALTH BENEFITS (NIHB)

- The Non-Insured Health Benefits (NIHB) program provides eligible First Nations and Inuit clients with coverage for health benefits that are not covered through other social programs, private insurance plans, or provincial or territorial health insurance.
- Many suppliers are enrolled with NIHB and are paid directly by the program. If you are eligible for
 this program, and the supplier is enrolled with NIHB this means that you do not have to pay out of
 pocket or submit claims. The supplier does this on your behalf. If the supplier is not enrolled in the
 NIHB program, then you will have to submit a claim.
- Pre-approval is mandatory for most items. Ensure you call supplier to clarify.
- You should call the supplier ahead of time to organize supplies and start any paperwork required.

DISABILITY TAX CREDIT

- Some ostomy patients are eligible for the federal <u>Disability Tax Credit</u>.
- The Disability Tax Credit is a non-refundable tax credit used to reduce the amount of tax payable on your income.
- Talk to your health care provider for more information. They will need to sign a form for you. Please note there may be a fee associated to your health care provider completing the forms.

Yukon Communities

- Most Yukon communities do not have local pharmacies so ordering of ostomy supplies is is often done by ordering through pharmacies in located in the Whitehorse area.
- To prevent arriving back in the communities without any ostomy supplies, arrangements
 need to be made ahead of time, prior to discharge from hospital. This includes funding
 application, ordering supplies required through pharmacy and pick up of supplies before
 heading back into the community. The times note above for supplies to arrive from
 pharmacies are based on funding that has been approved so Yukoners discharged from
 hospital should have enough supplies to last at least two weeks until their supplies through
 the pharmacy arrive.
- If you have private insurance, you may be required to pay the pharmacy up front and then apply to your insurance plan for reimbursement. Contact your insurance company if you have any questions.

Out of Territory Travel

• Before travelling out of territory check with your ostomy funding source on what you need to do in the event you require ostomy supplies while out of territory.
